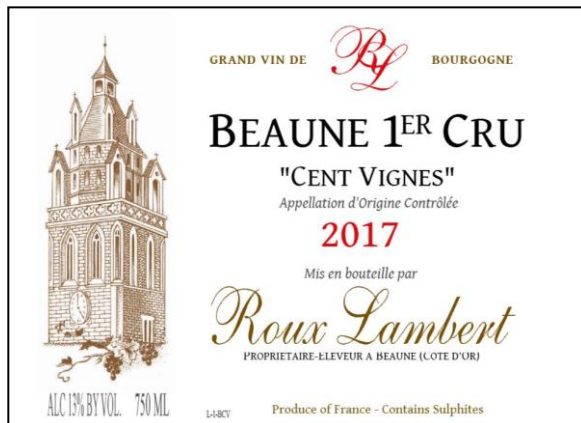


Roux-Lambert

Terroir : clay, sediments and limestones , on foothill, facing East in the northern part of Beaune. Vines are over 45 years old.

Winemaking & Maturation : hand-harvested, the grapes have fermented during 16 days and the wine has been matured in French oak for 12 months.

Wine description : Open on the nose with clean fruit aromas. It is appealing on the palate with open fruit, soft tannins, a lovely fresh toasted aftertaste. Supple and elegant.

Food and Wine : to serve with roasted chicken, mild cheese like Comté.

Ageing potential : Best after 5-7 years and 10-15 years in good vintages
